FOUNDATION GOVERNORS IN CATHOLIC SCHOOLS



KEY FACTS ABOUT FOUNDATION GOVERNORS

What is a Foundation Governor?

- They are appointed by the Bishop to represent his education policy in his schools
- They preserve and develop the Catholic ethos of the school

What do Foundation Governors do?

- Ensure the Catholic ethos is upheld
- Hold the Heads to account
- Oversee the curriculum
- Drive educational outcomes
- Provide assurance to the Trust Board



Who can be a Foundation Governor?

- You must be over the age of 18
- You must be a practising Catholic
- Experience and professional skills are a plus

What is the time commitment?

The average Foundation Governor role will take up around two hours a month including attending one Local Governing Body meeting per term and serving on one committee per term.
